

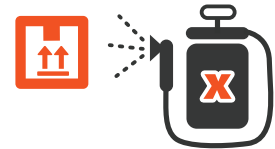
Sea Freight LCL Clearances... how does it all work?



You purchase your goods from overseas
Your goods are placed inside
a shipping container with other
people's goods



The container is placed onboard a ship
to bring your goods to Australia



If the goods are made from wood
they need to be fumigated prior
to shipping

While the goods travel to Australia,
Tight Ass Customs® will be busy
pre-clearing the cargo through
Customs and Quarantine



Once the goods arrive the
container is taken to a depot for
unpacking and separating.



Once the shipping container has been
unpacked you have 3 days to collect
(or Tight Ass Customs® can have your
goods delivered to you)

DAFF (Department of Agriculture
